Supplies:

Embroidery Machine and Largest Hoop- not a rotating hoop

Edge to Edge Embroidery Designs by Amelie Scott – your choice of design

If you have the Edge to Edge Quilting Book – please bring it

Fabric requirements for a small size quilt:

A quilt sandwich (top, batting, backing) " 45"x Width of Fabric (pin baste together before class)

For a Tote Bag:

A quilt sandwich (top, batting, backing) 24" x Width of Fabric (Pin baste together before class)

Thread – same thread weights for top and bobbin – You can use embroidery thread or a cotton quilting thread.

2 pieces of cutaway stabilizer to fit the hoop you are using. This will not be in your quilt. It is used as a template.

Quilting needles – size 90

Fabric marking pen – frixion is fine

Quilting Pins

Load the designs you want onto your machine or usb. There are two files for each design. An A and B. Load both designs.
