

Stencil, Stitch, Paint

Finished size approx. 15" wide x 27" long

Get your creative juices flowing with three techniques in one art quilt. Use stencils to make shell designs, stitch the designs onto fabric with decorative thread in the bobbin, and accent the designs with paint. Class fee includes the tool for painting and use of the instructor's stencils and paints.

Supplies:

- Sewing machine in good working order with straight stitch foot and free motion foot
- Sewing machine manual
- Straight stitch throat plate (has a circle hole for needle instead of rectangular hole)*
- Decorative bobbin case (for bobbin work)*
- 1 yard tear away stabilizer
- ½ yard of white Kona fabric
- 1/8 yard of fabric for inner border
- ½ yard of fabric for outer border and binding
- ½ yard of fabric for backing
- ½ yard of thin white cotton batting
- YLI Candlelight Metallic Yarn or Superior Threads Razzle Dazzle in color of your choice (I used Candlelight #034 Seafoam Blue)
- Cotton or polyester threads to match your Candlelight or Razzle Dazzle
- White thread and thread to match your border fabrics
- Empty bobbins
- Scissors
- Blue masking tape
- Pencil and eraser
- Straight pins
- Ruler, mat, and rotary cutter
- 90/14 Topstitch needles
- Large eye Easy Thread hand sewing needle

*If you have not done bobbin work before please plan ahead. You may need to order these for your machine.
