3 3/4 yards white or cream fabric for background and embroidered borders
1 yard tone on gone for word sashing
1 1/4 yard red tone on tone for inner border,
Seminole blocks and binding
2 yards Christmas print for outer border or 1 yard (if pieced)
8 yards Shape Flex by Pelion SF101
4 yards backing
65x65 batting

## **Embroidery Supply List:**

Brother adhesive tear away stabilizer (SA5815)
Medium tear away
Temporary adhesive spray
Removable marking pen
Small double curved scissors
Long pointy tweezers

Embroidery needles 80/12

Topstitch needles 90/14

Largest hoop

Embroidery bobbins either wound or prewound with white bobbin thread

Basic sewing supplies ruler, pins scissors and rotary cutter.

I used the following Floriani threads:

Black 900

Red 147

Brown 745

Purple 676

Orange 537

Gold 503

Yellow 501

Medium blue 3335

Light blue 332

Light green 243

Medium green 203

Dark green 206

White 730

If you would like to precut your fabric and iron the shape flex on the back you will get a lot more done in class. I would suggest preparing one piece 13x15 inches, one piece 28x15 inches.

On the 13 by 15 inch piece mark center lengthwise and width wise with removable marking pen.

On the 28 by 15 inch piece, draw a line down the center lengthwise and width wise. Draw a vertical line 6 inches from the center line on both the right and left side of center.

You will need your machine, embroidery unit, power cord.
