Tomorrow's Treasurers Llama Jumper Supply List Required Before Class

- 1) Basic sewing supplies:
 - Sharp Fabric Scissors, blade at least 4" long
 - Straight Pins at least 1 ¼ " long with a colored head (not craft pins)
 - Tap Measure 60" long, plastic, not cloth
 - Metal seam guide 5-6" long
 - Seam Ripper
 - Thread to match your fabrics
 - Standard foot, edge foot, and pipping foot for your sewing machine
 - Erasable/water soluble Fabric Marker or chalk marker
 - ½" Bias tape maker, Clover #464/12
 - Spray Starch
 - Fray Block
 - 70/10 universal sewing machine needles
 - Sewing Machine

NOTE: Store sample the fabric for the Jumper is the micro-cord corduroy, lining, bias trim and piping is 100% cotton; blouse is white pique; the Llama's body is white Minkie; all are available at Tomorrow's Treasures

- 2) Jumper
 - Pattern is Children's Corner, Kitty #262 available at Tomorrow's Treasurers
 - Embroidery design is Bit of Stitch "For the Love of Llama", design Luella ; available at Tomorrow's Treasurers; you will need for the embroidery design the following:
 - o Clean N Melt clear stabilizer for the Minkie
 - Floriani Threads, colors white PF800, PF900, Dark Pink, PF083,
 Pint 28415A, Green PF244, Teal PF222, and yellow PF302
 - For the flower on the bias binding you will need:
 - 18" of white ½" rick rack
 - 18" of lavender 1/8" rick rack
 - $\circ~$ one bead for the center
 - hand sewing needles

- Purchase all fabric and notions per the back of the pattern, add the following:
 - \circ 4 1/2" buttons I suggest these buttons have shanks
 - Interfacing either sew in or SFP101 fusible; small pieces for the buttonhole and button areas
 - White Minkie 8-10" square for the Llama
 - Purchase extra fabric of your chosen color about one yard, for piping and bias tape
- 3) Pre-Work Required,
 - Cut out the front of the Jumper 1" larger than your chosen pattern size. Now embroidery your Llama on the upper front of the jumper in the middle, about 2-3" down from the top edge, depending on pattern size. Re cut to pattern size once embroidery is completed.
 - Cut out the rest of all the pattern pieces
 - Make your piping for the top edge of the front of the jumper; I used 1" bias tape. Or purchase pre-made piping
 - Cut 1" bias tape the length of the bottom of the dress of your size, this is for the bottom trim on the jumper
 - Bring any leftover fabric from the jumper to class.

Note: If you need help completing the embroidery of the Llama make an appointment with the store. The jacket of the sample is Children's Corner, Robin's Little Jacket, #216. The blouse is part of the Jumper pattern.

NOTE: Sewing Machines:

You must bring along with your sewing machines the following:

- 1. Must bring the sewing machine attachments, feet (referenced above), screw driver, etc.
- 2. Must have owner's manual for your machine
- 3. Bring 2 extra bobbins with no thread
- 4. Remember to bring the power cord and foot pedal
