Petals Tote
Supply List Required Before Class

1) Basic sewing supplies:

- Sharp Fabric Scissors, blade at least 4" long
- Strong straight Pins at least 1 ¼ " long with a colored head
- Tap Measure 60" long, plastic, not cloth
- Metal seam guide 5-6" long
- Seam Ripper
- Thread to match your fabrics, plus bobbins to match your threads
- Standard foot, edge foot, zipper foot for your sewing machine
- Erasable/water soluble Fabric Marker or chalk marker
- Wonder Clips (if available bring multiple sizes from small to large)
- Stiletto or Awl
- 90/14 Topstitch sewing machine needles, you may need 2-4 for class
- 24" Ruler
- If making your own bias binding you will need the Bias Tape Maker ½" and spray starch I prefer Mary Ellen's Best Press
- Roxanne's Glue Baste-it
- Small iron with pressing mat (optional)
- Sewing Machine, prefer sewing machine with free arm feature

NOTE: Key decisions to make before class:

- Pattern calls for 2 different fabrics. The store sample tote has 4 different fabrics. When you choose 4 different fabrics you will need the following:
 - Fabric 1, one yard – Large petals, handles, and interior and exterior bottoms
 - Fabric 2, one yard – Small petals and handles
 - Fabric 3, one yard - Lining for tote, zipper pocket linings
 - Fabric 4 , ¾ yard – To make your own bias binding
 - When you are making the purse size the yardage above will be reduced accordingly see pattern information.
- Cosmetic Bag - Download this free bag from the Cozy Nest Design Website.

You will use your leftover fabrics to make this bag. You will need a 14" sport zipper.

2) Petals Tote

- Pattern is Petal Pockets Purse & Tote, available at Tomorrow's Treasures
- Purchase all fabric and notions per the back of the pattern, except for the following:
 - Zippers, please use standard zippers (used for garments) and not sport or metal zippers for the zipper pockets. For the Cosmetic bag I recommend the 14" sport zipper available at Tomorrow's Treasures.
 - D ring and hook with D ring to attach the cosmetic bag
 - Bring all leftover extra fabric to class
 - Ribbons to match for zipper pulls instead of coordinating fabric. Plus 18" of ¼" ribbon to attach the Cosmetic bag

3) Pre-Work Required,

- Trace the pattern pieces for the small and large petals
- Per page 1 of the pattern instructions Measure and Cut the Fabric Pieces.
 - When cutting the Upper lining cut this slightly wider 21 ½" for the tote and 16 ½" for the purse
- It is very helpful to mark your pieces as you cut them, use the printed labels on pattern piece sheet. Using the labels also helps in picking your main, lining, and coordinating fabrics for the tote and will be necessary to correctly place your pockets later.
- Fuse the interfacing to your pattern pieces per the pattern instructions
- When making your own bias binding please cut and sew together the following:
 - 2 1/3 yards of 1" wide for tote or 2 yards for purse
 - 6 ¾ yards of 2" wide for tote or 5 ½ yards for purse
 - Use the ½' bias maker to make the 1" wide binding. If you are not familiar with how to use this tool you can do this part in

class.

- **Do not** precut your bias binding pieces before class

NOTE: Sewing Machines:

You must bring along with your sewing machines the following:

1. All sewing machine accessories, feet (referenced above), screw driver, etc.
2. Must have owner's manual for your machine
3. Bring 2 extra bobbins with no thread
4. Remember to bring the power cord and foot pedal
