

**Tomorrow's Treasurers
Scarlett's Blouse & Skort
Supply List Required Before Class**

1) Basic sewing supplies:

- Sharp Fabric Scissors, at least 8" long
- Straight Pins at least 1 ¼ " long with a colored head (not craft pins)
- Tap Measure 60" long, plastic, not cloth
- Metal seam guide 5-6" long
- Seam Ripper
- Thread to match both your fabrics, and piping for the collar
- Standard foot, edge foot, open toe, and pipping foot for your sewing machine
- Erasable/water soluble Fabric Marker or chalk marker
- 70/10 universal sewing machine needles
- #8-9 Milliners needle for hand sewing
- #8 crewel embroidery needle to sew on the rick rack trim
- Silamide waxed hand sewing thread for the rick rack flowers
- Sulky invisible thread , 400m, 232, for your sewing machine
- ½" Bais tape maker, Clover #464/12
- Fray Block by June Taylor
- Spray Starch, prefer Mary Ellen's Best Press
- Roxanne Glue Base-it, or other liquid basting glue
- Tracing paper for marking (not white) with tracing wheel
- Pattern tracing paper
- Large pinning and pressing board recommend June Taylor Shape and Press Board
- Pressing ham and clapper
- Small iron, if available
- Sewing Machine
- Serger with coordinating thread (I will have available my serger during class with white thread) If your sewing machine has an overlock stitch that is an acceptable replacement for the serger.

NOTE: Store sample the fabric for the Blouse is white cotton pique, lined with white muslin; skort is periwinkle jean fabric; all fabrics are available at Tomorrow's Treasures.

2) Blouse

- Pattern – Bias & Blooms by Kari Mecca, available at Tomorrow's Treasurers
- Purchase all fabric and notions per the back of the pattern (all trim yardage is for all sizes, if you are making a 2-4 size you may have leftover trim), purchase the additional items listed below:
 - Interfacing for the collar can be sew in or fusible lightweight
 - 1-1 1/4 yards (depending on your chosen size) of batiste or muslin fabric for the lining of the front and back of the blouse
 - 1/4" button delete

3) Skort

- Pattern – Sweetheart Overalls by Kari Mecca, available at Tomorrow's Treasurers
- Fabric and Notions
 - Skort 1-1 1/2 yard depending on your chosen size
 - Two 3/8 – 1/2" buttons, prefer shank buttons
 - 3/4 -1" elastic 18-22" long depending on size
 - 2 1/2 - 4 yards for 1/4" bias trim depending on your chosen size

4) Trims used in store sample for Blouse and Skort size 4

- 2 yards of 3/4" rick rack light copen; large flowers
- 2 1/2 yards of 3/8" rick rack red; small flowers and part of large flowers
- 3 1/2 yards of 1/8" Nile green rick rack
- 3 yards 1/4" bias trim, T-44 multi, premade
- 2 yards of 1/4" bias trim, lime green gingham for the vines, premade
- 8 beads for red rick rack flowers
- 1 1/2 yards of cornflower piping, Susie's premade piping
- Embroidery Floss DMC 164 green

5) Pre-Work Required:

- Blouse
 - Trace off your chosen size from the pattern
 - Prewash your fabric for the blouse
 - Cut all pattern pieces from fabric and interfacing per the pattern instructions, except for the following:
 - Neck band bias binding cut 1 1/4" wide

- Cut the fronts and back only of your lining fabric
 - If using fusible interfacing for the collar fuse to wrong side of one collar piece only
 - No additional interfacing is needed for the front bands
- Bring any leftover fabric to class
- Skort
 - Trace off your chosen size from the pattern
 - Prewash your fabric
 - Cut all pattern pieces and interfacing for the back waistband only
 - If using fusible interfacing, fuse the interfacing to the back waistband only
 - Bring any leftover fabric to class

NOTE: Sewing/Serger Machines:

You must bring along with your sewing machines the following:

1. Must bring the sewing machine attachments, feet (referenced above), screw driver, etc.
2. Must have owner's manual for your machine
3. Bring 2 extra bobbins with no thread
4. Remember to bring the power cord and foot pedal
