Tomorrow's Treasurers Flipping Out Bag Supply List Required Before Class

- 1) Basic sewing supplies:
 - Sharp Fabric Scissors, blade at least 4" long
 - Strong straight Pins at least 1 ¼ " long with a colored head
 - Tap Measure 60" long, plastic, not cloth
 - Metal seam guide 5-6" long
 - Seam Ripper
 - Thread to match your fabrics
 - Also bring any leftover fabrics
 - Standard foot, edge foot, & zipper foot for your sewing machine
 - Erasable/water soluble Fabric Marker or chalk marker
 - Wonder Clips
 - Awl or Stiletto
 - 90/14 Topstitch (optional stretch needle 80/12) for sewing machine needles
 - Rotary Cutter optional
 - Sewing Machine
- 2) Flipping Out Bags
 - Pattern Flipping Out Bags, by Annie, available at Tomorrow's Treasurers
 - Purchase all fabric and notions per the back of the pattern, for the fusible interfacing I substituted SF101 for SUP179, all available at Tomorrow's Treasures
- 3) Pre-Work optional,
 - Trace and cut out the three circle pieces on page 7 of the pattern
 - Cut out the pattern pieces from your chosen fabrics and size, see the labels on page 8 to help you keep track of your pattern pieces.
 - For the small bag, my store sample does not have ribbon trim
 - For the large bag, I added ribbon with rick rack for the trim
 - Quilt the base on page 3, item E, numbers 1 and 2; number 3 we will do in class

- Fuse interfacing to main body piece, page 3, item F, number 1
- Quilt body lining on page 4, item G. number 1 only (recommend you quilt the body lining as I did on both of my samples)
- Metal zippers are not acceptable for this project, recommend you use a sport zipper and not a standard zipper
- The bias binding; the pattern calls for 2" wide, I found it easier sew with 2 ¼" wide

NOTE: Sewing Machines:

You must bring along with your sewing machines the following:

- 1. All sewing machine accessories, feet (referenced above), screw driver, etc.
- 2. Must have owner's manual for your machine
- 3. Bring 2 extra bobbins with no thread
- 4. Remember to bring the power cord and foot pedal
