### Ornament Hotpads

This month we will be making cute and usable Snowflake Hotpads. They can be displayed as a part of your holiday décor when you are not using them. They also make-up fairly quickly and make a great last minute gift. The die this month is the GO! Snowflakes 7" # 55450. Go to [www. Accuquilt.com](http://www.Accuquilt.com) and go to the free patterns and search for the Ornament Hotpads and then print out the instructions for the class. We will be making one hotpad in class so choose which color you want to make and which snowflake you want to use for the class.

Supply List: for all 3 Hotpads (In addition to the General Sewing Supplies)

- Accuquilter die cutting machine
- Dies: GO! Snowflakes 7" # 55450 ; if you have GO! Big Circle 4", 6", 7", 8" #55462 or GO! Circle 8" #55360 bring them to cut the 8" circle. If you do not have either of the circle dies I have an 8" acrylic circle template you can use.
- 1/3 yd. of each- blue, red, and green tone on tone fabrics
- Fusible Web: (3) pieces of 7 1/2" squares
- Backing: (3) pieces of 9" x 12" fabric
- Insulbright : (3) pieces of 9" x 12"
- Batting: (3) pieces of 9" x 12" (I have added this for additional insulation for the hotpad)
- Die mats
- Printed out instructions for the Ornament Hotpads
