

Flip & Fold Jumble Purse

Supply List for April 30th, 2024

This purse is an embroidery design done in the hoop. There will be three hoopings and then we will need to sew it together on regular machines.

Basic sewing supplies:

1. A machine that has the option to embroider and sew.
2. Hoops to fit the size of the purse that you would like to make. (My preference is the 6x10 or 7x12. The 5x7 is quite small to work with)
3. Stabilizers.... medium cut away and medium tear away.
4. Extra needles embroidery and sewing. I suggest a jeans needle for sewing the purse together.
5. Rotary cutter & matt, ruler, pins, wonder clips.
6. Scissors & Snippers.

Supplies for project:

1. Purchase & download the embroidery pattern from The Sweet pea website. (Swpea.com. https://swpea.com/products/flip-fold-jumble-purse-5x7-6x10-7x12?_pos=224&_sid=04472f5a0&_ss=r)
2. Cotton fabrics for the outside of the bag. There are 18 pieces on each side of the purse. You can choose as many different colors as you would like, or as little as you would like. I have made it a point to choose a number that is divisible by 18, so the repeat would be even. (just my thing). You can use large scraps for these if you have them.
3. Cotton fabric for the lining.
4. If you would like to add a cross body strap you will need
 - a) Cotton fabric for strap, cut 1.75 wide by 52" long. (may need to connect pieces to create the length)
 - b) Two small ½ inch d rings
 - c) ½ inch slider if you would like the strap to be adjustable
5. Zipper to match project (not metal) at least 7" or longer.
6. Neutral sewing thread to put all the colors that you have chosen together. (white, natural or grey)
7. Two pieces of batting, One for each side of the purse.
8. A decorative thread to do the quilting on the outside of each panel. (I really like variegated embroidery thread for this, depending on my colors. Whatever you feel will finish it off nicely)
9. 1 nylon zipper at least 10" long.
