Summer Blooms Tablerunner June 24 and 25 10 am to 3 pm

In this class we will use the Scan N Cut to scan the paper pattern to create and cut the applique pieces. We then use BES4 to import the Scan N Cut files to create the machine embroidery to stitch the appliques to the background fabric. We will also explore using the Dream Machine or Luminiar to scan and create the machine embroidery applique.

Supplies

Please bring to class:

- Scan N Cut machine, 12 x 12 standard mat and standard blade
- Optional scanning mat if you have it
- Laptop with Canvas Workspace and BES4 installed
- Summer Blooms quilt pattern by KariePatch Designs
- Painter's tape
- 2 yards for Heat N Bond Lite
- Iron and pressing cloth
- No Show Mesh Stabilizer
- Embroidery machine and 9x14 hoop
- Embroidery threads to match or compliment the applique pieces
- Embroidery scanning frame, magnets and stylus
- Cotton thread to stitch the grass piece to the background
- Fabric
 - We will be using the Summer Blooms quilt pattern to make a tablerunner. Here is an approximation for the amount of fabric used. Please adjust for your desire.
 - Grass: ¼ yard by width of green fabric. This includes enough for 2 strips of binding for the grass area and the 4 x 43 piece for grass.
 - Background: 5/8 yard for background. This includes enough for 2 strips of binding for the background area and 1 piece of 15 x 43 piece for background.
 - Flower Petals: 5 different fat quarters in bright colors
 - Stems and leaves: 1/3 yard for stems this green should be different color from grass
 - Flower centers, butterfly and caterpillar: 5 different 6" squares in colors that coordinate with the flowers. (There will be leftover fabric from the flower petal pieces that can also be used but more fabric variety is best.)
