

Lg Dresden Mat 9/4/2024 10-3

Instructions for the 8” Mat. Templates to copy are in the folder at the shop so you can prepare your fabrics in advance. These are very helpful especially if you want to “fussy cut” your fabric. All over prints use less fabric because you can alternate the direction of the template. The back petals are cut in 8 sections & front petals are cut in 16 sections.

You will need to download the 8” Mat Parts A, B, C & Centre onto a jump drive. It’s less confusing if you download only the size you are making.

2 Layers of Fabric type Wash Away Stabilizer for 8 hoopings.

8 Pieces of batting the size of the back section

8 pieces of the backing fabric

16 pieces of front fabric.

Centre Circle will require a front & back & a piece of batting

PREPARE all the pieces with an iron on stabilizer.

Thread & at least 5 bobbins pre-wound with your matching thread

SHARP Scissors. (Applique scissors work best. The centre will require very sharp scissors

Pins & Tape

Small ruler or Seam gauge

This design is put together totally in the hoop. It will go together like a puzzle in 9 hoopings. Each section being attached to the previous section. This Mat can be made in many colors or if you prefer it could be done in 1 color. Finished size of this 8” design is about 21” circle.

This mat is done in 8 hoopings. Each hooping will do 2 petals at a time. This will be constructed totally in the hoop connecting the previous section. Part A is the only loner.....it will be attached to Part B in the 2<sup>nd</sup> hooping. Part B is made 6 times each being attached to the prior one. Part C will connect to the last part B & Part A.
