In this class you will layer, safety pin base 2 different fabrics and practice stippling in order to make 2 placemats.

Classes will be in the Studio, 10:00 to 1:00

Fee: \$30.00

Materials:

- Sewing machine with free motion quilting foot and can do free motion quilting without using feed dogs.
- Fabrics – 1/2 yards of 2 different fabrics, 1/2 yard for binding (we will make it bias). **This will make 2 placemats.**
- Batting – 100 % cotton or 80 cotton/20 polyester, about 20 x 45 inches
- Quilting gloves
- Thread for machine quilting – cotton or machine embroidery thread (you will use the same thread in the bobbin) I used Sulky, 30 wt cotton, variegated works well also.
- Size 90 topstitch machine needle, quilters safety pins, a roll of blue painter's tape and basic sewing supplies
- Pattern paper to copy my pattern about 19 x 16 inches, extra paper if you want to copy another pattern.

I will bring several placemat patterns for you to choose from.

**** Before class wash and press your fabrics with spray starch**

NOTE: 1 yard of 2 different fabrics will make 4 placemats, then you will need extra fabric for the bias binding about 3/4yard
