

The supply list is the same for all classes.

For all the classes this yardage will make all (12) blocks:

-1 yard. Novelty print fabric

-(3) coordinating tone on tone prints: 2 yds each. Note: I used one coordinating color-purple for the sample and chose a dark, medium, and light tone on tone purple.

You can do what I did or select assorted colors that coordinate with the novelty print.

- 2 yds. white/neutral tone on tone background fabric to coordinate with the novelty print fabric

These fabrics will be for all the classes to make a total of (12) blocks.

-Sewing machine in good working order along with the power cord, foot pedal, and manual

- All feet that you have for your sewing machine.

- 1/4" and open toe feet

- Quilter's Wand Acrylic ruler

- Bloc Loc 4 1/2" and 6 1/2" rulers recommended

-Neutral sewing thread

- Flat head pins

- Cutting mat, acrylic rulers- 8 1/2" x 24", 8 1/2" x 12", 4 1/2" square ruler, 6 1/2" ruler

- Rotary cutter with extra blades for that size rotary cutter

- Scissors, seam ripper and any other notions you need to have a better quilting experience

You will receive the patterns at the class, and the shop has the cutting instructions for the class if you would like to cut the pieces for the blocks before class. If you do not feel comfortable cutting the pieces before class, that is ok and you can cut them in class, no problem. (The suggestion was made to provide the cutting instructions prior to class so I am providing that for those who would like to do so).
