

Supply List for Table Runner: December: Winter theme: Cardiff pattern with variations

Note:

- Students will only be making the quilt top in class so there is no need to bring the backing and batting to class.
- Students can cut the pieces and label them before the class.
- Students can make the top like the sample or how the pattern states; both fabric requirements are provided. The winter themed sample is slightly smaller than the quilt in the book since the black sashing strips are eliminated.
- **Students need to purchase the Tabletastics 3 book and bring to class.**
- If you do not already own the optional Bloc-Loc Half-Rectangle Triangle ruler set that is fine. The instructor has a work around for this ruler.
- **Please go to the upper level where the classroom is located.**

Fabrics for the pattern in the book:

- 1/3 yd. white tone on tone fabric for the borders and sashing
- (12) 10" med/dark coordinating squares; layers cakes work well for this
- 7/8 yd. black tone on tone fabric for sashing strips

Fabrics for the displayed winter themed sample:

- 1/2 yd. white tone on tone fabric for the borders and sashing
- (3) 3/4 yd. fabrics in winter or other themed fabrics

General sewing supplies to include:

- Sewing machine in good working order along with power cord, pedal, any specialty feet (walking foot, open toe foot, zipper foot usually and any specific feet required) and extension cord
- Sewing machine needles, 80/12; 90/14, topstitch needle, jeans needle, metallic needle and/or any other needles required for the project.
- Cutting mat, rotary cutter with extra blade, and acrylic rulers for project (multiple rulers from the same manufacturer unless specified by instructor) Any specialty rulers required for class.
- Portable iron and ironing mat
- Scissors, seam ripper, heat resistant pins, wonder clips, marking pens, pencil, matching and neutral threads, fabric glue stick, hand sewing needle, stiletto-bamboo stick-awl, and any other notions that the quilter normally uses for a similar project or specific notions required by the instructor.
