## Tomorrow's Treasurers Let's Sew Club - September Sew In Style Thread Catcher Supply List Required Before Class

- 1) Basic sewing supplies:
  - Sharp Fabric Scissors, blade at least 4" long
  - Strong straight Pins long yellow -topped quilting pins
  - Tap Measure 60" long, plastic, not cloth
  - Metal seam guide 5-6" long
  - Seam Ripper
  - Thread to match your fabrics
  - Standard foot, and edge foot for your sewing machine
  - Erasable/water soluble Fabric Marker or chalk marker
  - Wonder Clips (if available bring multiple sizes from small to large)
  - Stiletto or Awl
  - 90/14 Topstitch sewing machine needles
  - Mini Iron with pressing mat and seam pressing tool (optional)
  - Ruler 6" X 24"
  - Rotary cutter and mat
  - Glue Gun (optional, instructor will provide one for class)
  - Rubberized non-slip fabric (optional, instructor will provide for the class)
  - Polyfil for pin cushion instead of crushed walnut shells
  - Sewing Machine with power cord and foot pedal plus owner's manual
- 2) Sew In Style Thread Catcher
  - Pattern is Sew In Style Thread Catcher by Curry Bungalow available at Tomorrow's Treasurers
  - Purchase all fabric and notions per the back of the pattern except for the following:
    - No Velcro needed
    - Interfacing can be fusible either SF101 or light weight Pellon
    - Instead of the ceramic tile consider using two wood pieces 4" X
      6" same as shop sample; should you choose the wood option let the instructor know before class so wood pieces will be

available

- $\circ~$  Steam-a-seam may be substituted for Heat N Bond
- For the posy button prefer a shank 5/8" button
- ¼" boning just as easily as ½" boning
- Bring all leftover extra fabric to class
- 3) Pre-Work Required,
  - Shop sample used 4 fat quarters; make your fabric selections accordingly
  - Page 1 & 2 Cut pieces as indicated on page 2 except for the following:
    - If using wood cut 2 each of fabric and 2 of cotton batting all 8" X 6"
    - If not using fabric scraps for the pin cushion then cut 2 pieces of fabric and one piece of cotton batting, all 6.5" X 5", when using wood instead of ceramic tile
  - Fuse interfacing to wrong side of outer bag fabric when using fusible interfacing; otherwise base sew-in interfacing to wrong side of outer bag fabric 8" X 18"

## **NOTE: Sewing Machines:**

You must bring along with your sewing machines the following:

- 1. All sewing machine accessories, feet (referenced above), screw driver, etc.
- 2. Must have owner's manual for your machine
- 3. Bring 2 extra bobbins with no thread
- 4. Remember to bring the power cord and foot pedal
